



On Feb. 17, 2009, all over-the-air broadcast TV will switch to a new digital format. Millions of viewers will need to install a special **digital DTV converter box** in order to keep watching free TV. **Now is the time to get the information you need** to make the switch.

Who will be affected by the transition?

If your TV is more than two years old, and is connected to an antenna instead of cable or satellite, you will need a digital TV converter box.

What do I need to do to get ready?

Order a free coupon from the government, good for \$40 off the price of a DTV converter box (most boxes cost between \$40 and \$80). Order coupons online at **www.dtv2009.gov** or by calling **1-888-DTV-2009**.

Get your coupon as soon as possible – it will take three weeks for the government to respond. Also, **order an extra coupon** even if you don't need it – they're free (limit 2 coupons per household). You can donate your extra coupons to elders, shut-ins, group home residents, prisoners or others who may have special difficulty preparing for the Feb. 17 transition.
